Primary Function:

As a valuable member of the Technical Production Team, you will work closely with the rest of the Technical Production Team and Operations Division to organise and deliver a variety of conferences, events and exhibitions for the EICC. A key aspect of this role is the ability to streamline front of house builds, operation, derig and turnaround of shows to ensure the professional & seamless delivery of client events.

Key Responsibilities:

- Dealing with all aspects of the coordination, building and successful running of all AV aspects of events at the EICC, with a particular focus on lighting, in conjunction with the Technical Planners
- Establish and maintain good control room and equipment handling procedures to ensure maximum efficiency of resource
- Implementation of the Technical Production Team's safe systems of work and procedures
- Ensuring EICC equipment resource is used to best advantage before hire equipment is considered
- Undertaking the technical operation of events
- Building relationships with Contractors and ensuring the delivery and development of the Planned Preventative Maintenance program throughout the Facility in conjunction with the Head of ICT & Technical Operations
- Building relationships with equipment suppliers to ensure seamless and costeffective integration of external equipment when required
- Work on other EICC business projects as deemed necessary

Personal Attributes:

The successful candidate will ideally possess the following personal attributes:

- Experience working with AV technology and equipment
- Strong lighting skills including reading/drawing plans, rigging & focusing lights, programming & operating a modern lighting desk and maintaining equipment
- Experience with networking and IP based lighting control protocols
- Ability to prioritise workloads and adapt to changing demands
- Excellent communication skills
- Ability to follow detailed event planning information and then lead & deliver AV aspects of the event
- Ability to lead a team of technicians/contractors across all technical event disciplines

Key Selection Criteria:

- Track record of delivering technical production services in a professional environment
- A technician with previously demonstrated experience in lighting as well as wider departments, such as, Rigging, Sound, Lighting, Projection, Video, IT and online conference services
- Logical and calm approach to problem solving
- Proactive team player who is willing to be flexible with their time to meet the needs of the business and our clients including weekends/evenings
- Ability to work well within a team and give as well as take instruction as necessary
- Ability to lead a team of technicians to deliver an efficient and successful event
- Ability to work calmly under pressure to deliver to deadlines
- Excellent multi-tasking abilities
- Experience in delivering a high level of customer service
- Excellent time management skills with the ability to meet business and client deadlines
